	1. BDRC membership is required for using the Light Horse area, to vote at general meetings and to compete for year- end awards (if offered)
	2. Reading and understanding the Rules and Regulations is the responsibility of the member (and their parent/guardian in the case of a Youth or Junior). Members found to not be in compliance with any of these Rules & Regulations, may have membership privileges suspended or terminated, and not knowing or understanding a rule will not be an acceptable excuse. Parents/guardians are responsible to ensure the Intermediate or Youth member/s they are responsible are complying with the Rules and Regulations.
	3. As per the Memorandum of Understanding between the B&DRC and NTFF&RA I/we understand that training horses for the public, or providing coaching/instruction to the public, or receiving coaching/instruction is not permitted <i>unless as a sanctioned B&DRC event</i> . This is due to the Insurance structure of both parties.
	4. HCBC membership is required for ALL members & proof of current HCBC membership must be provided with membership application.
	5. Attire: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Helmets are encouraged for all riders, riders under 18 are REQUIRED to wear a properly fitted BSI or ASTM approved helmet, with safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted on the grounds. • Helmets are required in all English classes at horse shows for all ages, no hunt caps. • Boots with a proper riding heel are required for ALL riders. • Failure to wear required attire will result in elimination from the event, no refund of fees and any points earned will be lost.
	6. As Member(s) of the B&DRC I/we understand that I/we have the opportunity to use the Light Horse Area (warm up pen, main arena, and pens) for our riding pleasure, and agree to abide by these Rules for Use: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any props used must be removed from arena and returned to storage location. Do NOT use garbage cans for props • If your riding has created holes in footing (eg .barrel racing) level the footing in those areas • Ensure all gates are closed • Ensure any garbage is placed in the cans provided • Clean all hay/manure from pens if used. Covered stalls are not to be used without prior arrangements being made through the BDRC with the NTFFRA. • Abuse of horses on the grounds will not be tolerated & may lead to disqualification of the participant in question, at the discretion of the B&DRC event committee, or subject to Rule #2 at the discretion of the Board.
	7. A \$25.00 NSF Fee will be charged on returned cheques.
	8. The B&DRC Event Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes or entire events as entries dictate. Notification of any changes will be provided prior to the event starting, or at the start of the event in relation to class changes.
	9. Stallions may only be ridden or handled at B&DRC events by a CAPABLE adult (over 18 years of age). Stallions may NOT be used as mounts for Lead Line classes.
	10. The B&DRC reserves the right to request that the handler of ANY horse remove the animal from the grounds if its conduct is considered dangerous to the safety of the rider/handler, other participants, spectators, etc.
	11. Dogs are NOT permitted in the arena or warm up arena, unless as part of a specific event. All dogs must be kept on a leash and handled by a responsible adult while on the NTFF & Rodeo grounds.
	12. ALL horses and riders participating in our events, or using the facilities do so AT THEIR OWN RISK the Barriere and District Riding Club or its Officers will not be held responsible for any claim for injury/damage to any horse, person or personal property whatsoever.
