GENERAL INFORMATION

- These shows are governed by the Horse Council of BC current Rule Book (www.hcbc.ca) PLEASE read the rules for the classes you wish to enter.
- These shows are sanctioned Horse Council of BC events – **ALL competitors require HCBC Membership.**
- Show will start with Dressage, start time will be no later than 9am, but may be earlier if entries dictate. Ride times will be emailed by the Thursday night to dressage participants. English classes start following Dressage. An email will be sent to all competitors with the approximate start time. Be sure to include email on entry form.
- Stabling available – outdoor pens or covered stalls, fees apply – see fees section.
- Riders may ride a maximum of 2 dressage tests per horse. Horses may only be entered once per test.
- Snaffle bits may be used on any age of horse for Western Dressage Tests and for Western Walk/Jog classes. For all other classes horses
- Horses entered in the Western Performance Senior & Youth classes that are 6 years of age or older must be shown one handed in a shank bit. Horses 5 & under may show 2 handed in a snaffle or bosal. Hackamores not allowed.
- Green Horses of any age may be ridden 2 handed in a snaffle bit in the Walk/Jog class. A green horse is in its first year of showing.
- Horse/rider combinations *testing at dressage levels requiring lope/canter* work may NOT enter the walk/jog-trot performance classes.
- Riders competing in lope/canter performance classes may test in walk/jog-trot Dressage, but dressage points will not count toward high point or buckle series, only Training and above. Will be eligible for dressage year end awards.
- Classes may be combined/cancelled at the discretion of Show Management.
- Age Groups - Youth 17 and Under, Senior 18 & Over, Pee Wee 8 & Under
- Leadline: 6 years old & Under (HCBC Rule), entry will not be allowed to show unless the following are met:
 - The horse must be led by an Adult 19 years or older
 - Adult must be wearing proper Western or English show attire
 - Halter with lead shank must be worn under bridle
 - Leadline riders may not enter any other mounted classes, but may enter Showmanship

Dressage Ring Size will depend on arena being shown in – Agriplex (20x57), Light Horse Arena (20x40), Rodeo Arena (20x60).

Admin Fee - \$10.00 per rider

Entry Deadlines will be strictly adhered to. Anyone entering after entry deadline will pay \$25 late fee.

No entries accepted on the day of the show.

Entries may be withdrawn with a refund until entry closing date (less Admin Fee) with a medical or veterinary release. After entry closing date partial refunds may be given at the discretion of the show committee.

Stalls/Pens available - \$15/day plus separate refundable clean out fee of \$20. This can be a cheque or cash – returnable once stall/pen is inspected.

AWARDS

- Ribbons to 4th place in all classes
- Day High Point Awards for each division to follow last Trail/Handy Horse Entry, allow 15-20 minutes for calculation. Please be in your full show attire for prize presentations (photos)

BUCKLE SERIES

- Open to both BDRC Members AND Non-Members,
- Senior, Youth, Walk-Jog Senior, Walk-Jog Youth Champion buckles to be awarded.
- Must enter 3 of 4 shows to qualify, however points earned at all shows determine Series Champions.
- All classes count for points, including Dressage. Points are based on placing & number of horses in class.
- Points are earned on same horse/rider combination
- Awards will be presented at the end of the day with Day Awards following Sept 14 show. Must be present to receive award. Full show attire required for awards presentation (photos)



BDRC MEMBERS ONLY - WESTERN TWO-PHASE CHAMPIONSHIP

- Must enter Western Dressage and Trail.
- Points are calculated from all shows during the year, open to all categories, same horse/rider combination
- Year End Two-Phase Champion Award will be presented at Year End Awards.

BDRC MEMBERS ONLY - YEAR END AWARDS

- Must enter a minimum of 2 shows to Qualify AND meet volunteer requirements
- Awards in each Division (Senior, Youth, Walk-Jog Senior, Walk-Jog Youth)
- Western Dressage awards in each Level (Walk-Jog, Training, First Level and Overall)
- Number of placings in each category determined by number of qualified competitors

EVERY RIDER (or Parent/Guardian) SHALL CAREFULLY READ THIS NOTICE BEFORE SIGNING. NO PERSON WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE PRIOR TO SIGNING THIS FORM AS REQUIRED.

"Inherent risks of equine activities" shall mean those dangers or conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including, but not limited to: the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity; the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; the equine's response to certain hazards such as surface and subsurface objects; collisions with other equines, animals, people and objects; the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability.

Neither the sanctioning organization(s), the Barriere & District Riding Club, North Thompson Fall Fair Association, property owner(s), lessee(s), this equine event, the members of its organizing committee, officials, volunteers, staff, nor agents shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage, loss or for any other matter that may happen to exhibitors competitors, owners, agents, or to anyone on the grounds or to any animal or article brought to the grounds. Club Function Rules & Regulations

Please initial each clause to indicate you understand it.

1. HCBC membership is required for all participants & proof of current year membership must be given at time of registration. _____
2. Boots with a proper riding heel are required for ALL riders. Failure to wear proper footwear will result in expulsion from the event with no refund of fees. _____
3. ASTM/SEI-approved helmets are required for all riders under the age of 19 years, and all riders in over-fences classes. Failure to wear a proper helmet will result in expulsion from the event with no refund of fees. _____
4. Abuse of horses on the grounds will not be tolerated & may lead to disqualification of the participant in question, at the discretion of the B&DRC Show Committee. _____
5. Participants must display good sportsmanship at all times while on the grounds. These are family events & inappropriate language or conduct will not be tolerated. _____
6. To ensure the safety of everyone, horses must be led or ridden ONLY AT A WALK outside of the arena or warm up pen. _____
7. All events begin promptly at the specified times. Participants not ready at the gate to enter the arena when class is called will forfeit their participation in the event with no refund of fees. _____
8. Payment of fees may be made by cheque or cash prior to competing. \$25 fee for NSF Cheques. _____
9. Stallions may only be handled by Senior competitors (19+), and are not permissible mounts for Leadline entries. _____
10. The B&DRC Event Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes as entries dictate. Notification of any changes will be provided prior to each class. _____
11. Stalls are available to rent for each function at stated rates. A \$20.00 refundable deposit is required and will be returned to the owner at the end of the day if the stall is left clean & no damage has been incurred. Only 1 horse per stall is permitted. _____
12. Judges' /Management's decision is final. Any protests must be made in writing to the event secretary along with a \$50 cash deposit within 12 hours
