**ASSOCIATE MEMBER AGREEMENT**

An Associate Member is one who WILL NOT BE MOUNTED on a horse during a B & DRC sponsored event.

I am fully aware that I am joining the B&DRC as an Associate Member and that, due to HCBC Insurance requirements, my participation in Club activities is limited. I am not permitted to participate in any B&DRC sponsored event: including but not limited to: trail rides, fun days, clinics (excluding vet clinics & seminars), riding lessons, parades and shows. This is not a comprehensive list and all other B&DRC sponsored events that may take place from time to time are understood to be included. As an Associate Member I am permitted to take part in all volunteer work, including assisting at the Club sanctioned events, but I cannot be a mounted participant or exhibitor in any of those events. I may however participate in parades as a walking member or sitting on a club float. I have read the above and am fully aware of and agree to abide by, the restrictions on non-riding members. **Light Horse Area Rules for Users:**

As Member(s) of the B&DRC I/we understand that I/we have the opportunity to use the Light Horse Area (warm up pen, main arena, and pens) for our riding pleasure, and agree to abide by the Rules for Use:

- For INSURANCE purposes ALL users MUST be members in good standing of the Barriere & District Riding Club or North Thompson Fall Fair & Rodeo Association.
- All riders 18 years old and under MUST WEAR A HELMET
- Any props used must be removed from arena and returned to storage location. Do NOT use garbage cans for props
- If your riding has created holes in footing (eg .barrel racing) level the footing in those areas
- Ensure all gates are closed
- Ensure any garbage is in the cans provided
- Clean all hay/manure from pens if used. Covered stalls are **not** to be used without prior arrangements being made through the BDRC with the NTFFRA.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times

As per the Memorandum of Understanding between the B&DRC and NTFF&RA I/we understand that training horses for the public, or providing coaching/instruction to the public is not permitted unless as a sanctioned B&DRC event. This is due to the Insurance structure of both parties.

**BARRIERE & DISTRICT RIDING CLUB**

Club Function Rules & Regulations

This Rules & Regulations Form is Valid for all B&DRC sanctioned events for the year of membership

Please initial each clause indicating you have read & fully understand each clause

1. HCBC membership is required for **ALL** participants & proof of current year HCBC membership must be given **at time of registration.** \_\_\_\_\_
  2. A B&DRC riding membership cannot be rescinded to an Associate B&DRC membership during the current year in order to participate in our sponsored events \_\_\_\_\_
  3. Boots with a proper riding heel are required for **ALL** riders. Failure to wear proper footwear will result in expulsion from the event with no refund of fees. \_\_\_\_\_
  4. ASTM/SEI-approved helmets are required for all riders under the age of 19 years. Failure to wear a proper helmet will result in expulsion from the event with no refund of fees. We strongly urge all adult riders to wear helmets as well. \_\_\_\_\_
  5. Abuse of horses on the grounds will not be tolerated & may lead to disqualification of the participant in question, at the discretion of the B&DRC event committee. \_\_\_\_\_
  6. Participants must display good sportsmanship at all times while on the grounds. These are family events & inappropriate language or conduct will not be tolerated. \_\_\_\_\_
  7. To ensure the safety of everyone, horses must be led **ONLY AT A WALK** in the alley between the warm-up pen, parking lot and event waiting area. \_\_\_\_\_
  8. Only horses, their riders and handlers for Lead Line, participating in the current event will be allowed into the waiting area/warm up arena. All gates must be kept clear and no pedestrians, children, adults or dogs are to obstruct any passage way including the area between the spectator stands and the arena fencing. No rider/spectator shall sit on any fence during our events. \_\_\_\_\_
  9. All events begin promptly at the specified times. Participants not ready at the gate to enter the arena when called will forfeit their participation in the event with no refund of fees. \_\_\_\_\_
  10. Payment of fees may be made online upon registration or by cheque or cash by ½ hour prior to start time on the morning of the event. A \$25.00 NSF Fee will be charged on returned cheques. \_\_\_\_\_
  11. The B&DRC Event Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes as entries dictate. Notification of any changes will be provided prior to each class. **Late entries will not be accepted unless stated in the entry package along with any additional fees.** \_\_\_\_\_
  12. On-Line Registrations and Mail-in closing dates will be clearly posted for each event. Each class has a participation limit and may require the events to be held over 2 days. \_\_\_\_\_
  13. Pens and/or covered stalls will be available for rent at each event, with a rental fee. A \$20.00 refundable deposit is required and will be returned to the owner at the end of the day if the stall is left clean & no damage has been incurred. Only 1 horse per pen/stall is permitted. \_\_\_\_\_
  14. **Dogs are not permitted in the arena or warm up arena, unless as part of a specific event. All dogs must be kept on a leash and handled by a responsible adult while on the NTFF & Rodeo grounds.** \_\_\_\_\_
- \*ALL HORSES AND RIDERS PARTICIPATING IN OUR EVENTS DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK THE BARRIERE AND DISTRICT RIDING CLUB OR ITS OFFICERS WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CLAIM FOR INJURY/DAMAGE TO ANY HORSE, PERSON OR PERSONAL PROPERTY WHATSOEVER.
